Under the broad title of “Innovations in Medical Practice and Education: East meets the West” the program started with an overview of Advanced cardiac life support by Dr. Joseph Florence and ‘Application of Simulation’ by Dr. Beth Ann Fox, both Faculty members at the East Tennessee University.
